

### Travelling to Maidwell Hall

**By Air:** Both Birmingham and Luton Airports are just over 1 hour away by road and are within easy reach of Maidwell Hall. Both have regular scheduled flights from UK, European and International destinations.

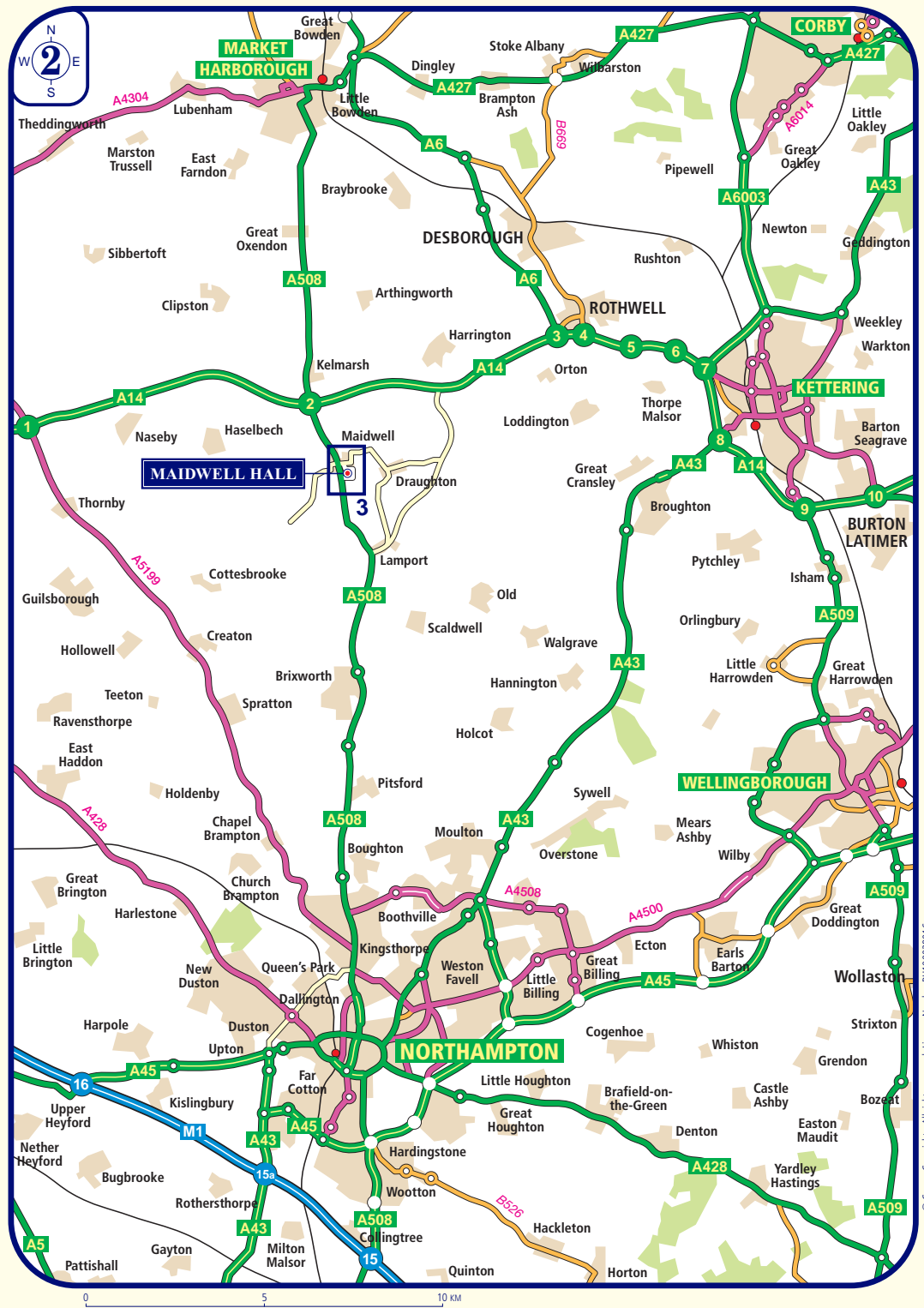
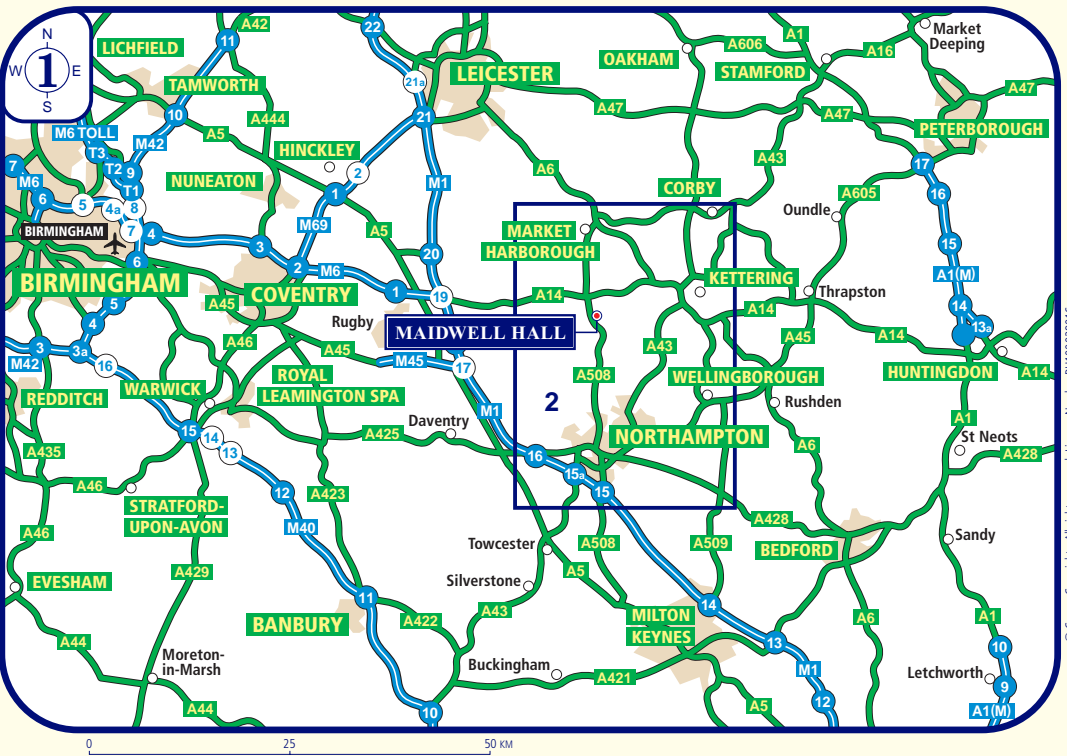
**By Rail:** The nearest main line station is Kettering, a 15 minute taxi journey away, and has regular services operating to London St Pancras and around the Midlands.

**By Road:** Maidwell Hall is situated on the A508, close to the A14, to the north of Northampton and the M1, making it easily accessible from all directions.

**From the M1:** Exit at Junction 15a and join the A43 towards Northampton. Travel straight across two roundabouts towards Duston. At the third roundabout continue straight on for Duston. At the crossroad junction lights follow signs to Dallington. Continue over roundabout at junction of the A428 in the direction of Kingsthorpe. Continue over the next roundabout and keep going until traffic lights at junction of the A508 with the Cock Inn on your left. Turn left onto the A508 through Kingsthorpe in the direction of Market Harborough. Remain on the A508 for approximately 11 miles and on approaching Maidwell the entrance to our drive is on your right.

**From the A14:** Exit at Junction 2 and join the A508 signposted to Northampton. Travel for just over 1 mile into Maidwell and the entrance to our drive is the second turning on your left as you exit the village.

**On Arrival:** Car Parking is available outside the Front Entrance. Visitors are then requested to report to the School Office.
